

Fire Warden Course Outline

Background

The Fire Warden course has been designed to meet the requirements of The Fire Precautions (Workplace) Regulations 1997 (as amended 1999) and the Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005 which is due to come in to force on in October 2006.

The Reform Order will replace over 100 pieces of legislation regarding fire safety. It will become the sole piece of legislation dealing with fire safety. It requires the 'responsible person' of every workplace where people are employed to carry out a fire risk assessment and to nominate a sufficient number of competent persons (Fire Wardens) to assist in implementing the procedures identified in that fire risk assessment.

Who Should Attend

Anyone responsible for overseeing fire safety, designated Fire Wardens, and anyone who needs to know how to use fire extinguishers. Previous experience and/or qualifications are not a requirement.

Course Objectives

Delegates will receive an insight into the Fire Regulations and general fire precautions, and will be trained to be effective Fire Wardens.

Course content

- The role of the Fire Warden
- Liaison with the Fire Service
- Action on discovering fire
- Fire safety legislation
- The chemistry of the fire
- Common causes of fire
- Fire safety precautions
- Fire drills and evacuation
- How to use fire extinguishers

Course duration

Approximately 4 hours.

The course tutor will carry out an on-going assessment and successful students will receive an approved certificate.
