



IOSH Managing Safely Course Outline

This is a 4 day course for those who need to manage environmental issues in compliance with their organisation's policy, legislation and best practice.

Objectives of the Course

Upon successful completion of the course, delegates should be able to:

- ✓ Identify hazards to the environment both generally and from an organisational perspective
- ✓ Apply management principles and advise on good management practice relating to environmental issues
- ✓ Communicate environmental practices effectively to all levels of staff in an organisation, including senior management
- ✓ Introduce environmental reviews taking into account current good practice
- ✓ Explain the component parts of an environmental management system, such as ISO 14001
- ✓ Recognise that adequate and appropriate information, training and supervision relating to environmental issues is required for employees
- ✓ Identify the responsibilities or organisations regarding compliance with environmental legislation.
