



IOSH Managing Safely Course Outline

The IOSH Managing Safely course is designed for people in supervisory or management positions in all types of organisations, who need a broad understanding of health and safety at work.

By the end of the course, delegates will be able to:

- ✓ recognise commonly found workplace hazards and know how to control those hazards
- ✓ determine why accidents involving injury or damage occur in the workplace
- ✓ explain how aspects of human behaviour can affect health and safety at work
- ✓ apply principles of good management to health and safety
- ✓ be able to use effective communication
- ✓ make sure that health and safety law is obeyed within their own workplace
